This will be the 3rd year they have been visiting—new this year: we will give each child a lanyard with a pocket to keep their library card safe.

Programs:

~Just an update on some recent adult programs: 12 people attended our How to Grow Mushrooms program, which was really great considering it was on a weekday afternoon. Our new Evening Thriller Book Club had 11 people attend. This is huge for us, since our last attempt at holding an evening book club (a year ago) averaged 4 attendees. Our Afternoon Book Club in September had 16 attendees; the program room was full of readers!

Facilities:

~At the time of this writing, a portion of our sidewalk and parking lot on the East side are being replaced, as part of the Village sidewalk program. Hopefully this will create a smoother entrance/exit for our visitors.

Grants/Donations:

"We are participating in the WI Science Festival. I applied for, and received, 50 science bags for children that we will hand out during the Festival Week (Oct 16-25). The bags contain a variety of activities such as exploring our environment, experimenting with sound, chromatography, and coding.

"We received the final \$500 of our STEM kits grant. Because of this grant we were able to purchase 22 kits. They are circulating well and families have commented how nice it is to have such materials to checkout.

"We received a \$500 donation from a local family, to be used as I see fit."
